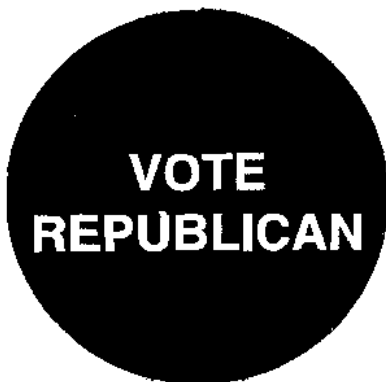

Dear Neighbor:

DuPage County is at the heart of the Republican Party in Illinois. Milton Township is at the heart of DuPage County, and at 26%. Milton Township had the highest percentage Republican turnout in the county on February 5. Many thanks to the 155 (36%) of the 431 registered voters in our precinct who cast Republican ballots in the election. We should be proud of that high turnout -- only 7 of Milton's 109 precincts had a higher percentage Republican turnout. 109,358 (20%) of DuPage County's 549,621 registered voters cast Republican ballots. 19,632 (26%) of Milton Township's 76,578 registered voters cast Republican ballots. A special thanks to the 132 who voted to reelect me as your Republican Precinct Committeeman. On February 7, 8, & 9 I attended the Conservative Political Action Conference (CPAC) at the Omni Shoreham Hotel in Washington DC. I was in the audience when Vice President Cheney spoke, when Romney announced his withdrawal, when McCain spoke, when President Bush spoke, when Huckabee spoke, and when Gingrich spoke. On February 16, I conducted a TAPROOT Republicans of Illinois breakfast meeting in Lombard at which Pat Brady, a member of the McCain 2008 National Finance Committee, a McCain Delegate, and a long time friend of McCain spoke for McCain. On February 17, I attended an open house that Congressman Roskam held for his volunteers. On February 18, I heard Congresswoman Biggert speak at the Lisle Township Republican Organization's monthly meeting. On February 20, I attended the McCain press conference in Sugar Grove. On February 27, I will attend the Milton Township Republican Central Committee's officer election meeting. On March 5, I will attend the DuPage County Republican Central Committee's Bi-Annual County Convention. The November 4 general election will be here before we know it.
