Dear Neighbor and Fellow Republican:

Thank you very much for voting Republican in the March 21 primary election. Your voting in the election helped keep our precinct's reputation as being one of the most Republican precincts in the township, in the county, in the state, and in the country.

THE ELECTION

As I stated in my April 17 letter and as we are all aware, the winners in the eight contested races were **Judy Baar Topinka, Joe Birkett, Randy Hultgren, Mike Fortner, Gwen Henry, John Zaruba, Jerry McBride, and Mike Formento.** As I stated in my letter:

-- 38 percent or 156 of the 410 of the registered voters in our precinct 9 voted in the March 21 primary election

-- 81 percent or 127 of the 156 who voted in our precinct, voted Republican – only 8 of the 109 Milton Township precincts had a higher percentage

-- 31 percent or 127 of the 410 of the registered voters in our precincts voted Republican -- only 23 precincts in the township had a higher percentage

-- Our 31 percent Republican turnout is better than it looks – the two precincts most comparable to ours, precinct 19 immediately to the west and precinct 86 immediately to the east, had only 27 and 22 percent Republican turnouts respectively

-- At 24 percent (17,475 of 72,260), the Republican turnout for Milton Township overall was the highest of the nine townships in DuPage County – the Republican turnout was 19 percent (98,104 of 518,275) for all of DuPage County

-- At 88 percent the vote for **John Zaruba** in our precinct was the 3rd highest of the Milton Township precincts; at 38 percent, the vote for **Steve Rauschenberger** was 4th highest; at 63 percent, the vote for **Grant Eckhoff** was 9th highest; at 89 percent, the vote for **Randy Hultgren** was the 11th highest; at 39 percent, the vote for **Jim Oberweis** was 12th highest; and at 62 percent, the vote for **Mike Fortner** was also the 12th highest.
