Transportation

Been the driving force behind nearly every major transportation initiative in the area for the last 25 years. From working to reduce HOV restrictions on I-66, to leading the effort to bring mass transit out the Dulles corridor, no one has worked harder to help ease congestion in the region than Congressman Wolf. Accomplishments include:

- Securing federal funding for improvements to the I-66 / Route 29 interchange.
- Pushing to widen westbound I-66 from Rosslyn to the Dulles connector.
- Working to obtain federal funds to purchase additional rail cars for VRE. Highway Safety.
- Obtained federal highway funds for safety improvements on Route 50, Route 17 and Route 15.
- Supported the effort to ban trucks on Route 17 between Route 50 and I-66 and worked to lower speed limits on the highway.
- Been a leader in the effort to get unsafe trucks off our highways. As chairman of the House Transportation Appropriations subcommittee, Congressman Wolf was the driving force behind the creation of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration to oversee the trucking industry. This new federal agency is designed to more closely monitor the trucking industry nationwide and ensure that safety is a top priority.
- Teamed with Mothers Against Drunk Driving to require all 50 states to adopt the same standard to determine whether or not someone is driving drunk.

Historic Preservation

- Worked with Senator Warner and conservation groups to help the National Park Service acquire 445 acres of Ovoka Farm for the protection of the Appalachian National Scenic Trail near Ashby Gap.
- Secured federal funding to assist in the renovation of the Mosby House Museum in Warrenton.
- Introduced legislation to create The Journey Through Hallowed Ground National Heritage Area which follows U.S. Route 15 from Charlottesville north to Gettysburg.

Gang Violence

Provided the leadership - and secured federal funding - to create the Northern Virginia Regional Gang Task Force. Congressman Wolf is widely credited with bringing together local, state and federal law enforcement officials - including the FBI, U.S. Marshals Service and ATF - to address this very real and serious problem. Ensuring that your neighborhood - and the schools your children attend - are safe is foremost in Congressman Wolf's work for you.
